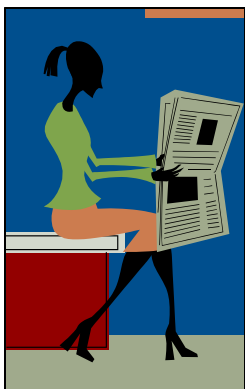

-Contains over 140 magazines and texts geared towards Middle School Children

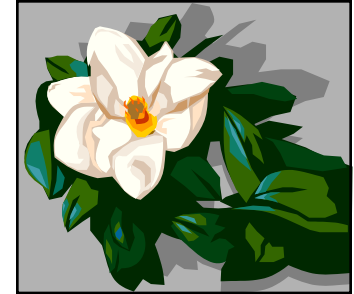
