Getting to the library can be a challenge during this busy season, so it's the perfect time to try digital eBooks and Audiobooks from the Northeast Regional website! You'll find new releases, classics, fiction and non-fiction, suspense, romance, and more. Digital items turn themselves in after 2 weeks unless you renew them (never a late fee!). All you need is your library card and the internet to set up your account; then in two simple steps, you're ready to read!

1. Go to the NERL website ([nereg.lib.ms.us](http://nereg.lib.ms.us)), click on Digital Resources, then RB Digital, and set up your account.

2. Download the RB Digital app from your device's App Store (Google Play Store, iTunes, etc.) and enter the info for the account that you just set up. That connects the RB Digital app on your device with your NERL account. Search eBooks and Audiobooks by author, title, genre, or date, or browse all titles to see what strikes your fancy. Checkout, renew, place holds, or return items right from your device.

Once your item is downloaded, you can read it anywhere - no internet connection is required to enjoy!
