Another Beans & Cornbread Success!

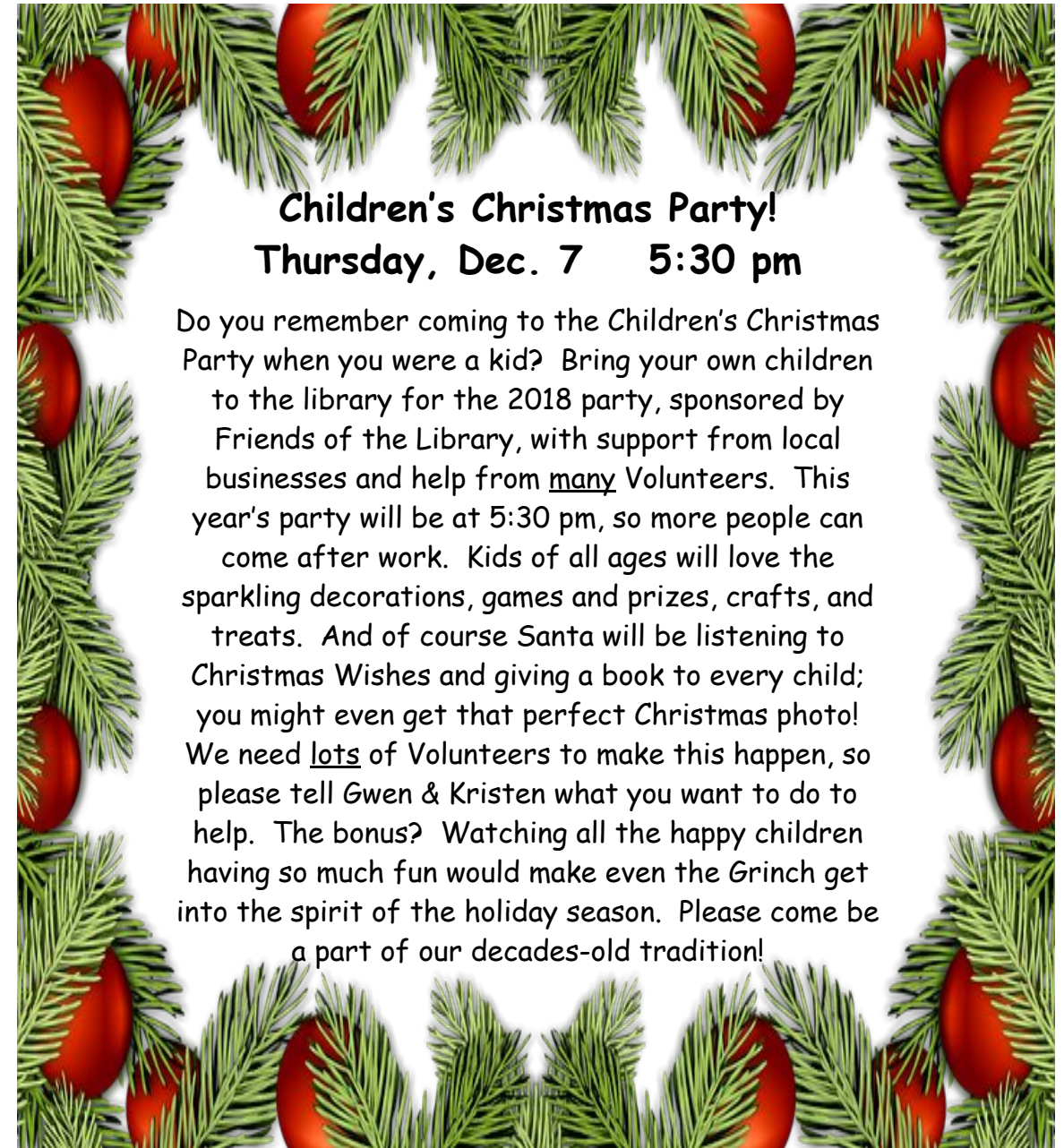
